




Amber warning **Rain**

Between 15:00 Mon 10 Jun 2019 and 23:00 Mon 10 Jun 2019



Flooding and transport disruption likely from heavy rain in southeast England during Monday afternoon and evening

What to expect

- Homes and businesses are likely to be flooded, causing damage to some buildings
- Delays and some cancellations to train and bus services are likely with spray and flooding probably leading to difficult driving conditions and some road closures
- Fast flowing floodwater is possible, causing danger to life
- Power cuts and loss of other services to some homes and businesses likely

Further details

Following earlier rainfall some heavy, and perhaps thundery, showers are expected to develop over parts of southeast England this afternoon and into the evening.

Whilst many areas will miss the highest rainfall totals from these some places could see 50-60 mm falling in the space of 4 to 6 hours.

The showers will then gradually ease later this evening.
