T A Fisher's Development Director and Cllr. P. Wingfield have been liaising regarding the meeting of interested parties to discuss the MOR006 reserved site. A meeting is still proposed, although this is proving difficult with the school's other current commitments.

18/174 **Minor Matters for Information Only:**

- SMPC have been asked to comment on a West Berkshire Council (WBC) consultation considering traffic restrictions. The proposals are for two areas 1) on The Street, opposite to the junction with Mortimer Lane, and to the right of Mortimer Lane opposite the junction with Church Farm Barns and 2) outside the Cinnamon Tree, across the roundabout and along the left hand verge. This will be taken to Full Council for consideration on the 11<sup>th</sup> April 2019.
- The loading restrictions relating to Budgens, in the recent proposed amendments to WBC's Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading, Parking Places and Residents' Parking Order, were removed and the order has now been passed.
- The following planning decisions had been received:
  - 19/00123/ADV Horse and Groom: further to SMPC objections, the plans were amended and have now been approved.
  - 19/00169/HOUSE 76 Victoria Road: SMPC had no objections and the plans were approved.
  - 19/00264/FULD 6 Victoria Road: SMPC objected to the roofline. Amended plans have been approved.
