20/0040 Minutes of Last Meeting

The Minutes of the Planning Committee meeting held on 6th August 2020 were received. It was noted that the addition of Mr. Kiley's name had been made to item 20/0030/a regarding a meeting with District Councillor Bridgman and Pro Vision on 6th August 2020, and the Minutes were duly APPROVED for signature by the Chairman as a true record of the meeting.

a. Mortimer Station Car Park Planning Application

No formal notification has been received from West Berkshire Council following the queries raised at the Eastern Area Planning Committee meeting on 5th August. Cllr. Morsley advised that this is one of the areas where an approach was being made to West Berkshire Council regarding the creation of a wildflower habitat.
