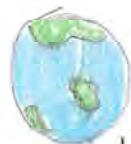

Dear The Mortimer Parish Council,



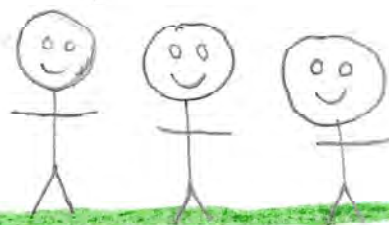
