## **Summary Queens Platinum 70th Jubilee Sub-Committee Activity**

- 1). In order to achieve a successful outcome on the week-end of June 3rd and 4<sup>th</sup> 2022, the Sub-Committee has been formed into a number of working parties to focus on specific areas of the activities to make sure that these are all successfully delivered. The groups have been created according to the skills of the individuals to make sure that we have the right people in the right place doing the right job.
- 2). Local groups are continuing to sign up for involvement on the day.
- 3). Offers of sponsorship are also being made to the event, in addition to the donation of lorries for the floats to take part in the procession on the Saturday and the vintage vehicles that have been made available to take part.
- 4). Costs are still being compiled, but a clearer picture is beginning to emerge:

Series of articles in the Village Eye from January onwards to publicise the event and raise awareness in the community! £780.00

Insurance to cover the 2 days of the event: (to be finalised) approx £2000.00

Cost of Parachute Display Team; (to be finalised) approx £4000.00

Cost of Musical Entertainment (MML to confirm) Circa £10,000

These costs remain within the range of the £20,000.00 seed funding.

Many organisations are offering their services and attractions for free.

5). Income and Sponsorship are also still being finalised.

Bar income: this to be based on similar MVP and MML events, approx.. £10,000.00

Sponsorship offers, TBC £7,000.00

Further income from other sources, such as the fair and food concessions is expected - £2,000.00

- 6). The sub-committee are working to make the event as green as possible, and the Plastic-Free Mortimer group have been invited to look at reducing the carbon-footprint of the activities, such as by restricting the use of disposables and providing recycling and composting bins on the site.
- 7). The Sub-Committee ask the Parish Council to clarify what would happen to any surplus made on the day? Would this be donated to local organisations, as it is the Sub-Committee's understanding that SMPC cannot make a profit? If so how should this be distributed?
