Summary

At the 19 January meeting the concerns were expressed at the cost and length of time take to complete the work on the site.

The crime level is currently low – the data is contained in the meeting minutes

There is low attendance from some member parishes and housing authority since faceto-face meetings reconvened – the vice chair has sent a note round the Clerks and members asking them to confirm their intention to attend.

Children on motorbikes in the woods at College Piece, Holden's Firs and Gibbet Piece was discussed. The police are aware and will increase patrols

Police are to investigate the illegal felling of trees in St Mary's Churchyard and the resulting damage to gravestones.

Concerns were raised over the number of cars parking on the pavements – notably Windmill Road, Victoria Road (café area) and West End Road. The police will patrol these roads and speak to those responsible.

Fly-tipping in farmer's fields was notes and the police were not aware and ask all farmers to report all cases.

Eggs being thrown at house windows (reported in Dec) and an individual stealing a parcel from a house on the lower street on or around Feb 27 was noted via Facebook and will be raised at the next meeting.
