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Scope and Specifications for Tree Condition Assessment Stratfield Mortimer Parish Council

Stratfield Mortimer Parish Council (SMPC) wish to procure a tree condition assessment at a site within the village of Mortimer:

- "Windmill Common"
- The woodland consists of, but not limited to, a mix of Oak, Beech, Scots Pine, ivy and herbaceous layer.
- The common is covered by a tree preservation order with West Berkshire Council: 201/21/0028 – A1.
- Survey can be carried out on a 'negative return' basis only recording the features which
 have a significant impact upon the condition of the trees. Where trees are identified as
 having significant features that have a significant impact upon the condition of the tree
 or the use of the site then the tree should be tagged and works detailed with a priority.

A previous survey was carried out in late 2019 with relevant treeworks taking place earlier this year after permission granted by West Berkshire Council (20/03100/TPW).

You are invited to submit proposals to carry out this work as follows:

vii.	Plotting of tree positions on Parish Online or similar system	£	
/iii.	Hourly rate for additional work	£	per hou

Together with our quotation, the Parish Council will also require:

- details of staff qualifications (NPTC certification)
- confirmation of your employers and public liability insurance
- a method statement of how the works would be carried out in a safe manner, considering the nature of the site
- confirmation that the works would be complete within a three-month period following instruction (or within an agreed timeframe)
- relevant experience and references from people in the local area would be useful.
