The group met on 17 October. Cllrs Dennett, Marsden, Hill, Lock and Carter attended. For a summary of the working party's remit please see the <u>last report</u>

1: CCTV

The investigation findings relating to possible Fairground CCTV. Cllrs Carter and Wells met the supplier of the Burghfield system and the parish clerk.

Action: seek a quote for Fairground CCTV, with the assumption it is a good members bid opportunity (Action: Cllr Carter)

2: Allotments

Engelfield recently appointed James Meade as head of rural land and property. Cllr Marsden is in touch with both and local landowner Jim Bryce. Four possible sites are under consideration of which the previously proposed land parallel with Cinnamon Tree is one.

3: EV charging

The WBC initiative to install charging on roadside where residents have no way to charge from the house, ground to a halt.

Action: Cllr Carter to forward roadside charging correspondence to Cllr Bridgman to progress at WBC.

4: Future uses of CIL/other capital funds

We discussed the path to/from Burghfield (the need for a total cost estimate), the reserved land behind Tower Gardens (clarify its possible uses), the café pavement (as a possible new project) and the idea of solar panels for community centre.

Action: Invite/encourage the Community Centre to apply for solar panels, under the WBC CIL fund offer (Action CIIr Hill)
