Windmill Common Tree Works

Decision Ref: 23/018 1.3 Roads, Footpaths & Commons Committee

Background

Following a ground level survey of the trees on Windmill Common, undertaken by Sapling Arboriculture on 24th April 2023, the Roads, Footpaths & Commons Committee of Stratfield Mortimer Parish Council resolved to have the recommended tree works carried out.

Windmill Common is to the north of Mortimer Common settlement with Longmoor Lane to the east, Windmill Hill to the south, Spring Lane to the west and fields to the north. There are a number of public rights of way across the public open space. There is a tree protection order on Windmill Common and the parish council have obtained consent from West Berkshire Council (see Decision Notice 23/01866/TPW).

Schedule of works

Tree works should be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998:2010 Recommendations for Tree Works and in particular biosecurity / avoidance of transmission of disease and pathogens (4.3), extent of pruning works (7.2.4), and natural target pruning (7.2.5).
