With respect to run-off on pre-developed sites the maximum discharge rate equivalent to 50% of the exiting 1 in 100 year runoff rate is not acceptable. There is normally an logarithmic relationship between probability and run-off data. Thus 50% of the existing runoff rate has a priority of about 0.1 i.e. is a 1 in 10 year event. This is unacceptable and could lead to relatively frequent flooding. A 1 in 50 year runoff rate would be much more appropriate
