## Agenda Item 24/119 Clerk's Report

### 1. Dog Waste Bin Signage

Tactical Facilities Management have labelled each dog waste bin with a reference number and their contact details. Should any issues arise with the bins, they will contact us directly to facilitate resolution.

### 2. Health and Safety

At the November meeting, concerns were raised regarding the slipperiness of certain areas of the MUGA surface. Following an inspection by Ashford Contract Services, it was advised that an over-skim may not be necessary at this stage. Instead, applying a colour coating could potentially extend the lifespan of the surface by up to 10 years before resurfacing is required, this would come at a significantly less cost than the over skim. Additionally, the Custodian has applied the "Wet and Forget" treatment, which has effectively addressed moss growth. To further maintain the surface, regular maintenance, including leaf blowing twice a week, is being carried out.

### 3. Precept

The precept request and a copy of the SMPC's summer 2025/2026 budget, which supports the precept submission, was sent to West Berkshire Council (WBC) on the 16 of January.

### 4. WI International Bee Day

The WI will be decorating the Fairground Fence for the month of May in celebration of International Bee Day, which is the 20<sup>th</sup> of May, they have agreed not to staple directly on the fence.

#### 5. Anti-social behaviour
