I am contacting you to seek your views about the need for measures to tackle speeding traffic on The Street in Mortimer.

Residents have been in touch with me to share concerns about the impact that speeding traffic has for pedestrians and other road users as well as to share the actions that they have already undertaken to highlight this issue.

I want to support the work that has already been undertaken by local residents and build a case for action to present to West Berkshire Council. I also wanted to share my concern about the closure of the Post Office counter at the Co-op in Mortimer and update you on what I have been doing. During the past fortnight, my team and I have been in contact with both the Post Office and the Co-op regarding the closure. I am clear that there needs to be a Post Office in Mortimer, and it is welcome that this assessment is shared by the Post Office and that they are currently seeking applications to take over the running of the service.

I have met with the Co-op and they have confirmed that the cash machine will remain at the store and they will be providing Paypoint services in store going forward which will allow customers to pay bills and top up.
