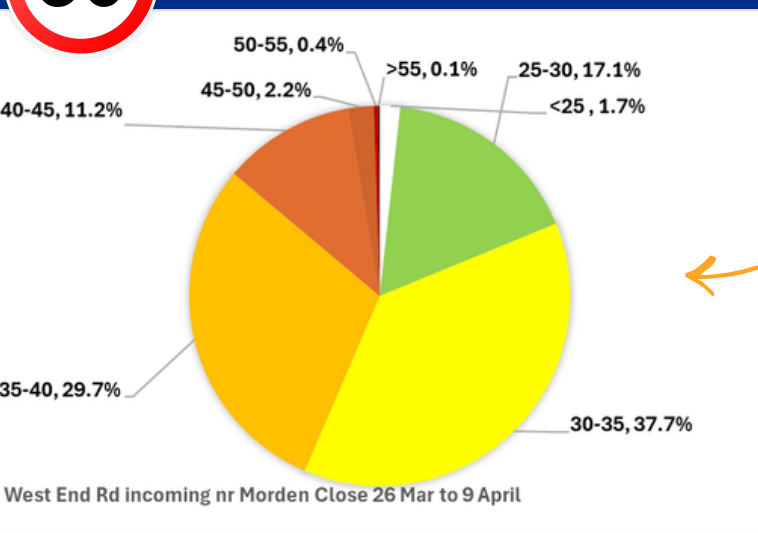

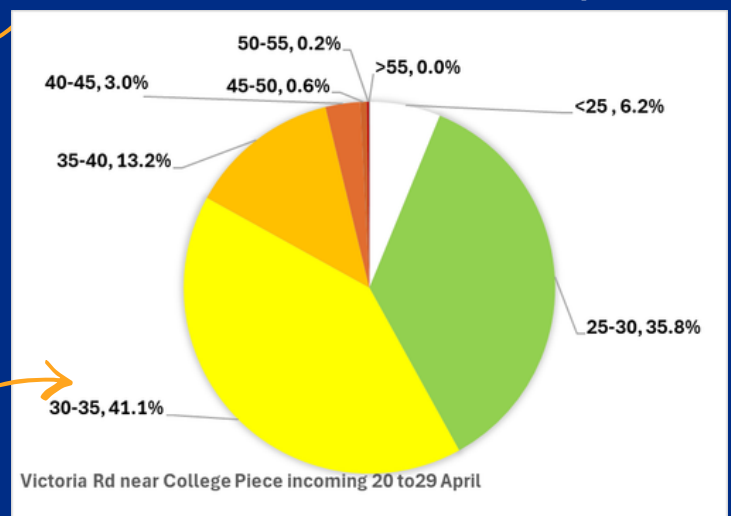

West End Road heading into the village from 26 March to 9 April recorded 23658 vehicles with 81% exceeding the speed limit with 44% at more than 35 mph



Victoria Rd near to College Piece heading into the village recorded 29176 vehicles with 58% exceeding the speed limit with 17% exceeding 35 mph.
