1 Play Equipment Complain

A member of the public reported that their child had grease or oil on their clothing following use of the play equipment at the Fairground. CCTV footage and a site inspection were reviewed. It was determined that the child had climbed onto the outdoor fitness equipment and had come into contact with an internal moving mechanism. The equipment was inspected and found to be functioning correctly with no defects identified. A report detailing the findings was provided to the resident.

2 Fairground Tree Concerns

A resident of King Street reported concerns regarding significant deadwood within an oak tree located on the Fairground at the rear of their property. The Council recently commissioned tree surveys across the Fairground and is currently awaiting the completed reports. Any works identified as necessary will be considered upon receipt of the survey findings.

3 Mortimer to Burghfield Cycleway – Burghfield Parish Council Correspondence

Following the Council's request for a financial contribution towards Phase C of the Mortimer to Burghfield Cycleway, Burghfield Parish Council requested additional information regarding the project, its funding position and expenditure to date. A detailed response was subsequently prepared and issued addressing all points raised.

4 Windmill Court Construction Traffic

A resident raised concerns regarding construction vehicles associated with the Windmill Court redevelopment parking dangerously near the junction of King Street and Windmill Road. The concerns were reported to Sovereign Network Group and the principal contractor. In response, the contractor has conducted a toolbox talk with all site operatives, updated site induction procedures and amended the Traffic Management Plan to prohibit contractor parking within 10 metres of the junction. The contractor has also confirmed that the area will be monitored each morning to ensure compliance.
