1 Tennis Courts

A resident reported a child regularly playing football within the tennis courts. CCTV footage has been reviewed and passed to the Neighbourhood Policing Team, who intend to carry out occasional patrols. The situation will continue to be monitored.

2 Fairground

Burghfield Football Club was found to be using the Fairground, including the cricket outfield, without prior authorisation. The Clerk has written to the club outlining the booking procedure and requirements for future use. No response has been received, however there have been no further reports of unauthorised use.

3 Mortimer to Burghfield Cycleway

- Phase B Works – Phase B of the cycleway, between Longmoor Lane and Three Firs Roundabout, has now commenced.
- Good Exchange Funding – The Parish Council's application for Phase C funding has been approved by The Good Exchange and is now live on their platform for donations and match funding.
- Three Firs Crossing – West Berkshire Council has confirmed that the new staggered crossing at Three Firs Roundabout has been issued to Volker Highways for delivery. The works will be coordinated with the Parish Council's Phase B construction programme. Due to ongoing SSE traffic management at the double roundabouts, the crossing works are now expected to take place later in the school summer holidays.

4 West End Road Car Park – Wildlife Border

The Clerk wrote to the Estate Management Committee in early June advising that the wildlife border at West End Road Car Park was becoming overgrown and attracting comments from residents. No responses or offers of volunteer assistance have been received. As the border continues to require maintenance, the Clerk suggests that the Committee considers future maintenance arrangements for the area.

5 Land Registry – Windmill Common

To note that the Land Registry title for Windmill Common has been updated to reflect the Parish Council's current office address. No further action is required.
