

Hire of Mortimer Fairground from [] to [] - Advertising

Further to our emails and your hiring of the Fairground as above, I want to check with you regarding any advertising that you might want to place on the Fairground (black metal) fence or elsewhere.

In accordance with The Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) (England) Regulations 2007 ("the Regulations"), the Parish Council acknowledges the rights of a travelling circus, fair or similar travelling entertainment to advertise its visit, provided that such advertisements comply with Schedule 3, Part 1, Paragraph 3F of the Regulations.

In order to check that there is compliance, and so that we don't simply remove advertising that you might put up, please could you confirm by return of email that you can answer "yes" to each of the following questions:

- Para 3F(1): All advertisements will be within a maximum size of 0.6 square metres.
- Para 3F(3): All advertisements will be removed within 7 days of the last performance/etc date.
- Para F(4): You have notified West Berkshire Council (as the Local Planning Authority) in writing at least 14 days before the first advertising date.
- The Council's Advertising and Fly Posting Policy: You will only secure an advertisement using a method which will not damage the fence (cable ties, string, etc).

Please note that if you can't answer "yes" to the first three questions above, that doesn't mean that we will refuse to allow you to advertise, but it will mean that we need to agree what advertisement(s) you might be allowed to place and where you might be permitted to place them.
