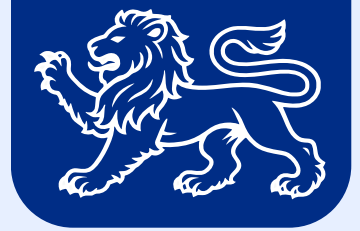

Mortimer–Burghfield Cycleway Update

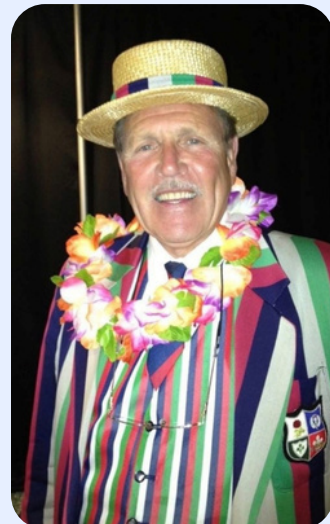
West Berkshire Council is constructing the new crossing associated with the Mortimer–Burghfield cycleway.

The surface along much of the new path will be compacted further once there has been sufficient rainfall. This will help the surface settle and allow the final compaction work to be completed more effectively.
